Shred-O-Rama



Weima WLK 15

It chips! It chops! It slices! It dices...it can make peanut butter! In September, Maine Plastics installed a brand new Weima (model WLK 15) shredder. As you can see from the pictures, we spared no expense. The set-up has an in-feed conveyor with an Eriez 1250 metal detector to stop the conveyor if any ferrous or non-ferrous metal is detected. The discharge conveyor has an Eriez magnetic belt to lift steel contamination right out of the shred for jobs that we feed from the top. The discharge conveyor has an Eriez, eddy current, ferrous and non-ferrous metal detector/seperator that segregates metal contamination before it reaches the final box. The discharge belt can feed the shred straight into a grinder or into a box for further processing.

You may be wondering what we plan to do with this monster machine. Quite simply, the answer is, feed it. It can take gaylord-size purgings. It can chew up cut-offs of most sizes and shapes. It can take large parts that won't fit into the mouth of any regular grinder. It can chop through gaylords of tangled runners that won't typically feed into a grinder. Got a VW Beetle to shred, or perhaps an old Pacer? This machine can crank out 2,500lbs-3,000lbs per hour of shredded plastic. Currently, we have open shredding capacity. We don't anticipate that this will last too long. If you would like us to toll shred/grind your scrap into regrind, call us. If you have **purge, lumps, chunks**, or tangled runners for sale that can be processed by a machine of this type, call us. We want your business.
